

Victorian Autism State Plan

In its 2006 election policy, **Addressing Disadvantage**, the Victorian Government undertook to:

... develop an Autism State Plan in partnership with Autism Victoria, to build new and better approaches across government for meeting the growing and complex needs of people with autism and Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD).

The Department of Human Services (DHS), the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development (DEECD), and Autism Victoria worked together in partnership to develop the Plan which was launched in May 2009 during Autism Awareness Month.

The role of the ASD Case Consultant Practitioner (ASD CCP) is a part of the Victorian Autism State Plan.

Currently the ASD CCP project is funded till June 2012.
